The festival takes place at The Deanery Project in Ship Harbour, Nova Scotia, unsurrendered Mi'Kmaq Territory. Throughout the event, festival attendees partake in creative, nature-inspired crafts and activities or simply explore and enjoy the trails and ocean front access on property. Evening programming brings science-based workshops, story-telling and a parade lit by lanterns down to the ocean where live performances take place among the twinkling bioluminescence in the water. The evenings conclude with live music on the stage and space to spread out blankets to watch for meteors and shooting stars. The atmosphere of this festival is dreamy, humble and always magical for all ages.

We like for performances to particularly intrigue children and families and to highlight, incoroporate or interact with the natural surroundings where the performance takes place. We are looking for 2 -3 performances ranging from 5 to 20 minutes. Each act will recieve an honorarium, free admission to the festival, tenting or bunk space and 2 meals.

Submissions will be reviewed by a diverse jury from both urban and rural settings from a variety of backgrounds. The application is intended to be accessible to artists from all levels. We welcome applications in whatever form feels appropriate for the artist. If the applicant does not speak English or prefers another language to express themself in their submission and/or in their art, we welcome them to do so.

The SeaLight SkyLight Festival is committed to working toward a more accessible, inclusive and diverse framework where artists and attendees feel visible, supported and empowered. We welcome any feedback or input at any point in this process and we look forward to your submissions.
